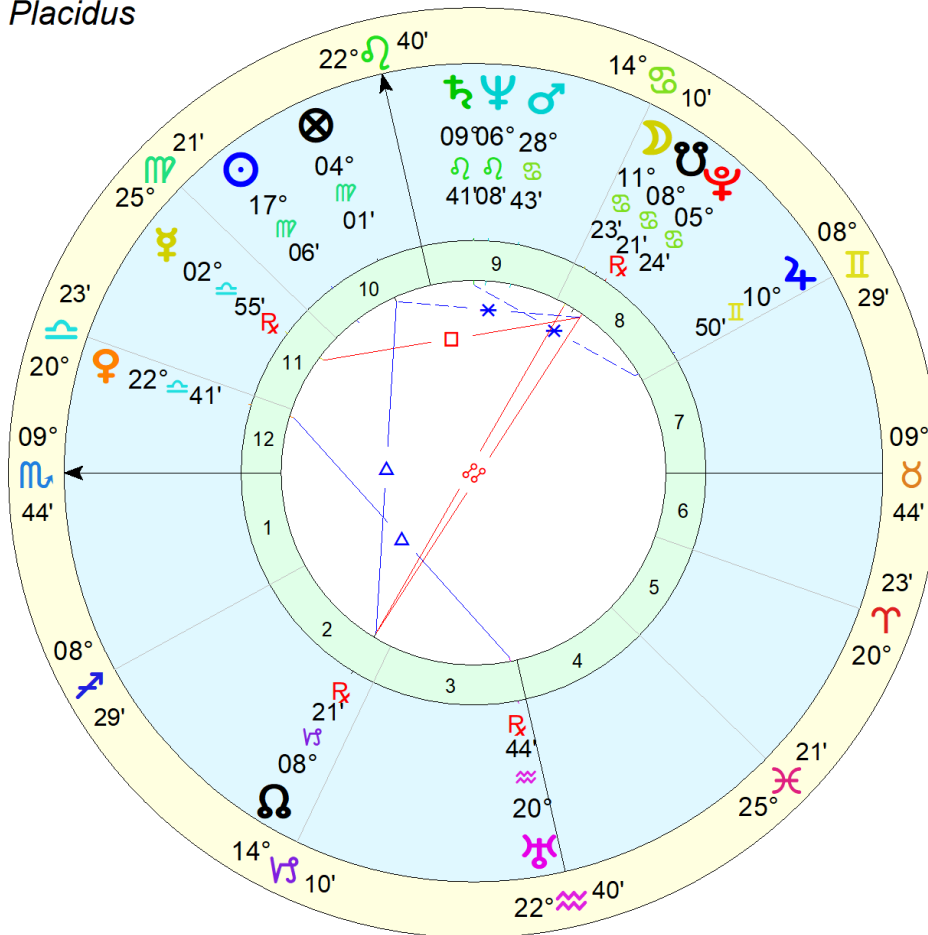

INTRODUCTION
