

#### The Sun

Sun Sign Astrology is very popular in modern times. Many people know their own Sun Sign. And it has become a common occurrence for personal introductions to include a reference to a person's Sun Sign. Just as the Sun is the centre of the earth's Solar System, so does the Sun play a vital role in your life on earth. Your personality and self-expression are linked to your Sun - its Zodiac Sign and its position in your chart. So, it's no wonder that Sun Signs have risen in recognition.

The Sun moves around the Zodiac every year and so you share your birthday and Sun Sign with many others. You can see enough similarities to pique your interest in astrology. It's important to note the Sun isn't the only planet to be considered in a person's chart, but it is an important component.

The Sun gives you an indication of how you can shine in your life. You feel truly alive when you're living the traits indicated by your Sun. Therefore, it's likely that you will spend much of your life on a journey to self-discovery, aiming to incorporate these traits into your life. Understanding the energy of your Sun is a good starting point to understanding yourself. Esoteric Astrology, or the astrology of the soul, also states that your Sun Sign is your personality, and is only a vehicle to your soul purpose which is indicated by your Ascendant or Rising Sign.

#### The Sun is in Libra

Your Sun is in the Zodiac Sign of Libra indicating that 'moderation in all things' could become your motto, as you strive to live a life of peace and harmony. This need for balance can be seen in all areas of your life, but particularly in personal relationships which play such a strong part in your life. Justice and fairness in interpersonal relationships are all-important. You can always see both sides of the story and therefore often find yourself in a peace-making or mediating role. You're diplomatic, and therefore carry out these roles well. Relationships play a prime role in your life. Partnership is important. However, make sure that you don't lose sight of your own objectives in your efforts to relate and to help others feel at ease. There can be a tendency to become so embroiled in the problems of others and in your efforts to make others feel at peace, that you forget about yourself. It is important to remember that you also enjoy the simple pleasures of pleasant company and beautiful surroundings and take time out to recharge your batteries. You can create, reconcile and bring the strongest opposing forces into line.

#### The Sun is in the 3rd Decan of Libra

Sun Sign Astrology has become so popular that people now introduce themselves by announcing their own Sun Sign. For instance, "hello, I am Steph and I am a Sagittarius, so I am usually pretty upbeat and positive". In this way the traits of a Sun Sign are claimed, owned and exchanged as accurate personal information. But did you know that your Sun Sign can be further dissected into three separate parts, called Decans. Decans are a system in which astrologers allocate different planets to every ten degrees of each Zodiac Sign. These Decans are sometimes referred to as Face. The Decans, or Face, date back as far as the 3rd Millennium BC, and are still used by astrologers in current times. Each Decan influences your Zodiac Sign in different ways, sometimes emphasising and sometimes adding a different flavour to your Zodiac Sign traits. You may like to look up the exact degrees of your Sun Sign so that you know if your Sun is in the 1st, 2nd or 3rd Decan. The first ten degrees equals the 1st Decan, the second ten degrees the 2nd and the third the 3rd Decan. The approximate dates for Libra are: Libra Decan 1: September 23 to October 3 Libra Decan 2: October 4 to October 12 Libra Decan 3: October 13 to October 22.

Do you love wide, open spaces and wonder why you find these so relaxing? Your Libra Sun is in the 3rd Decan ruled by expansive Jupiter triggering the need for you to yearn for freedom. Like fellow Librans, you enjoy peace and harmony and the company of others, avoiding drama whenever possible. However, this Decan highlights a personal quest to learn, expand your horizons and see life as a journey. You enjoy the company of others, as long as there are no squabbles. Your equilibrium is upset by unfair situations. The influence of planet Jupiter as your Decan ruler accentuates your quest for justice. You are unlikely to tolerate unfair treatment of any living being. The late Dame Anita Roddick was a prime example of this Sun Sign and Decan. She was an animal activist and committed ethical businesswoman, a world-wide phenomenon with her 'Body Shop' enterprise. You, too, can shine in areas that your promote your personal commitment to fair trade and the rights of others.

#### The Sun is in the 10th House

While this report focuses on the Sign of your Sun, it's also prudent to look at where your Sun is placed in your Birth Chart in relation to the Rising Sign, which sets different sectors. In astrology, these sectors are called the 'Houses' and indicate the areas of life through which your planets are expressed. Your Sun is in the 10th House of your Birth Chart meaning that you're the sort of person who likes to make your mark on the world, in particular through your profession. Depending on other influences in your chart you're likely to be born to parents of good standing in the community. From this favourable start in life, you're likely to steadily improve on your status. Success usually comes easily in whatever business or profession that you choose. People in high places are likely to look on you with favour, helping you further your ambitions. You're also likely to rise to a prominent position in society, perhaps even in government office. You've high moral standards, which you apply to yourself and to other people. Fortunately, your vitality and health are usually good and

therefore you're well able to achieve your goals. You're likely to carefully consider your proposed primary partner, before entering into a commitment which affects your standing in the community. As a result, depending on other influences in your chart, you're likely to benefit through your primary partnership. Ancient astrologers consider that the Sun is well-placed in the angular 10th House of a chart, and therefore, you're likely to be successful in achieving your goals.

## YOUR MOON SIGN

#### The Moon

Astrologers from different schools of thought allocate varying meanings to the Moon in a Birth Chart. Ancient astrologers say that the Moon changes its nature according to its phases, and merely passes on impressions from other planets rather than directly influencing a person's life. In other words, the Moon is said to reflect the light of other planets, emphasising them or shading them.

Modern astrologers tell us that the Moon depicts a person's roots, our home and family. They say the Moon also shows our habitual nature or subconscious patterns of behaviour which stand in the way of achieving our life goals. Modern astrology advises understanding our emotion nature and with it so that we can express our needs in a positive way.

Another form, Esoteric Astrology or astrology of the soul, tells us that the Moon represent the past, the obstacles that we need to overcome so that we can fulfil our soul's purpose. The Moon, according to Esoteric Astrology, is our past karma that blocks our soul's progress. So they suggest suppressing our needs as depicted by the Moon.

The approach in this report is that while the Moon can show us our strengths, it can also depict our weaknesses which need to be overcome in order to be successful in life.

#### The Moon is in Virgo

With the Moon in the Sign of Virgo you are practical, shy and ready to organise all of the other Signs. You love to have a sense of order in your life, and can often be found putting things straight. 'A place for everything, and everything in its place' is a good motto for you. For this reason, you enjoy schedules, catalogues, notice boards, diaries and calendars - all of which help put order into life. You also enjoy lists. Depending on other aspects in your Birth Chart, you simply can't relax in dirty or untidy surroundings, and become quite agitated until something is done. And everyone has a money story that has been passed on down through their family history, and is in situ when born. This could be a story of struggle, comfort or riches. As your money journey unfolds, and then later the story unravels, it's likely to have emotions associated with it. The Moon is the seat of emotions and so is intricately linked to your money story, and resultant money mindset. Money is often the exchange of emotions, and vice versa emotions affect how money flows. In learning more about your emotions, and their link to money, you can step into a more positive and powerful place in your life, and experience the flow of money that you most desire. Understanding your Moon Sign in your Horoscope can accelerate this process. Virgos love a list, or better still a spreadsheet. You are good with facts, figures and numbers. Both Virgo Sun and Moon individuals have a good understanding of economics. You can keep a tight rein on your personal finances, balancing the budget easily. You can work steadily towards your money goals with an efficiency that impresses all around you. You are prudent, unlikely to take financial risks although you love to see your money saved and possibly invested wisely. You are not wasteful, so can easily live on your earnings as well as save any extra. Like your fellow Earth Signs (Taurus and Capricorn) you learn the value of money early in life. Sometimes the placement of the Sun or Moon in Virgo can indicate growing up in an impoverished household or neighbourhood, and that can be the impetus to rise above your station. You work hard and methodically, saving, investing and improving your financial foundation. Virgo is an Earth Sign and all Earth Signs require some form of security. Yours may be financial, or you could value education, as the planet of communications Mercury is ruling your Sign. One way that you can distinguish yourself is through spending money on education, a form of bettering yourself or equipping yourself better for the workplace. Earlier in life you may live frugally while spending any money earned on study, training, or learning specialist skills. As you progress you become an expert in your field, and you can make the most of your experience by working as a trainer, teacher, writer or educator.

Let's look at one way of nurturing your Moon and that is through the art of aromatherapy. Like astrology, aromatherapy is an ancient craft. And while nothing replaces a professional consultation, you can explore the sensual world of aromatherapy by introducing some oils via Zodiac Signs. You could apply the following tips to your Sun and Rising Sign as well, but the Moon is the seat of emotions and responds well to positive effects of scent and touch. Also, the sense of smell is most closely linked to memory and emotions, and this connects directly to the astrological Moon. You may choose aromatherapy oils that enhance or strengthen your traits, or ones that calm or soothe. In your case your Moon is in Virgo and so ylang ylang, chamomile and melissa are beneficial for soothing feelings of being overwhelmed and for an overworked mind. Ginger, lemon, grapefruit, petitgrain and thyme help with excessive worrying and generally support good health. Other useful oils are sandalwood and frankincense, both great for stress and anxiety. Lavender is a great Virgo oil, because it's ruled by Mercury and has a clean fresh aroma but helps calm the system and promote sleep. Spearmint is good for digestion and refreshed mind.

On another note, let's look at the association between Zodiac Signs and colours. Experts say that colour has a powerful effect on the psyche, that it can be used to signal action, influence mood and even influence physiological reactions. They say that certain colours have been connected directly to calming moods, or increasing blood pressure, and influencing decisions. Perhaps the Moon which is most closely associated

with mood and emotions could be the colour of choice for you, but you may also feel like you really shine when you wear or see your Sun Sign colour. Virgo as an Earth Sign is linked with brown and green. Both of these colours represent the earth, the tending of the earth and its flora. Brown also represents stability, which is often craved by Virgo.

#### The Moon is in the 8th House

While this report focuses on the Sign of your Moon, it's also prudent to look at where your Moon is placed in your Birth Chart in relation to the Rising Sign, which sets different sectors. In astrology, these sectors are called the 'Houses' and indicate the areas of life through which your planets are expressed. The Moon is placed in the 8th House of your Birth Chart suggesting that you are a sensitive person. Your emotional antennae are switched on to "high". This may have something to do with an event connected to your mother or childhood. You may develop a facade to try to protect your sensitive feelings, but beneath this outer layer you are aware of the emotional undercurrents on most situations. As a result, you may develop a need to understand the cycles of life and the metaphysical nature of the world. Why do people behave in the way that they do? What affect do the natural cycles have on human behaviour? What happens after death? Why do certain events seem to be synchronised? These are all questions which could be food for thought. You may even go further and delve into metaphysical matters. On the other hand, you may seek security through the material world, and seek to accumulate wealth. Your early childhood experiences opened many doors of enquiry, which can't be closed. You've the ability to develop your interest in the occult world and to use your discoveries for practical results in your own and other people's lives. Although financial gain can't make up for the possible upsets that you suffered earlier in life, you're likely to benefit through inheritances, particularly from your mother's side of the family. This, of course, depends on other influences in your Birth Chart. In some cases, it's the lack of financial support during childhood which can deeply affect your adult life. If this is the case you may seek comfort through other people's resources - monetary and emotional - whether this is through joint projects or investments.

#### The Ascendant

The Ascendant or Rising Sign, is a key - if not the key - component of your Birth Chart. The Rising Sign is time sensitive and therefore considered the most personal point.

Ancient astrologers believed that the Ascendant depicted our primary motivation as individuals. Some believed that it was one of the links to discovering what makes a person happy. When we're accomplishing our primary motivation then we're happy.

The more modern Esoteric astrologers believe that this sensitive chart point reveals a person's soul purpose. And that fulfilling soul purpose contributes to a happy and joyful life. They believe that acceptance of purpose, or fate, can help a person achieve success and satisfaction, and that meditation on the qualities of the Ascendant can help anyone focus on life purpose. A sense of purpose can help overcome the most onerous difficulties in life by taking the focus away from failings and problems and shining a light on strengths and talents.

Esoteric Astrology, the astrology of the soul, espouses that your Sun Sign represents your personality, your Moon your obstacles, and your Ascendant, the way forward.

#### The Ascendant is in Capricorn

The Sign of Capricorn is considered to be 'feminine' by Ancient astrologers suggesting that you're more likely to wait until you feel comfortable before pursuing your purpose. You're also likely to depend on other people to take the initiative. Capricorn is also a Cardinal Sign denoting enterprise, enthusiasm, self-assertion and initiative.

You're ambitious, persistent, cautious, prudent and self-reliant. Responsibility and reserve often feature as your first choice of self-expression. You approach most things in life cautiously, making careful plans before starting anything new. You're a good worker, and take life rather seriously. You may have been shy as a young child with a serious nature and a maturity beyond your age. It's not until you're an adult that you grow in confidence, and find productive outlets for your wisdom. Your ambitions are attainable through hard work and perseverance. Others come to appreciate the fact that, in your own quiet manner, you can be relied on to complete a task. You earn the respect which is so important to you.

Are you destined to be active, or more sedentary? While the planet Mars is directly linked to sports and action, your Ascendant can also give you some hints as to the type of exercise that may appeal. With a Capricorn Ascendant, you can excel at any

sport that you set your mind to. You are more likely to be the manager of a team sports, rather than just a player. You may prefer your own company and the ability to set your own pace, and so golf could be the ideal activity, or you could take up rock climbing, or mountain bike riding.

In Esoteric astrology the Rising Sign or Ascendant is considered to be more important than your Sun or Moon Sign. Esoteric Astrology is the astrology of the soul, and the Ascendant is seen as your soul's purpose, or the 'sum of possibilities'. The Sun is seen as your personality, and the Moon as your past. The Ascendant is the moment that your soul chooses for your first breath on planet Earth giving it significance. Your Rising Sign of Capricorn is linked with spiritual initiation and the cycles of the universe. Your purpose is connected with showing other people the spiritual path through the example of your own life. You're also likely to play a part in building positive, possibly spiritual, structures in society. You need to ensure that your work on planet Earth is carried out with purpose and integrity so that you are always working towards the higher good, and leading by example.

Your Ascendant also represents your physical body, your health and happiness. Your body is the temple for your soul, so your health leads to your happiness, as does expressing your soul purpose. It's also possible that your energy system is connected to your Ascendant and therefore your most potent chakra. What is a chakra? A chakra is an energy points in your body, a point through which energy flows. And when each chakra flows freely, they are thought to bring harmony to your body, mind and emotions. There are seven chakras representing different areas of life and they are also said to be linked to the seven ancient planets and to the Zodiac Signs. Each has a specific function for the physical body, and provides connection to a larger power source. Chakras can have a deep connection to your spiritual and emotional wellbeing. You need to be cautious when it comes to making long-term deals, and signing contracts. It's also possible that you can succeed in running your own business, or in management. Sports management, or a pioneering field may appeal. You may be a born coach.
